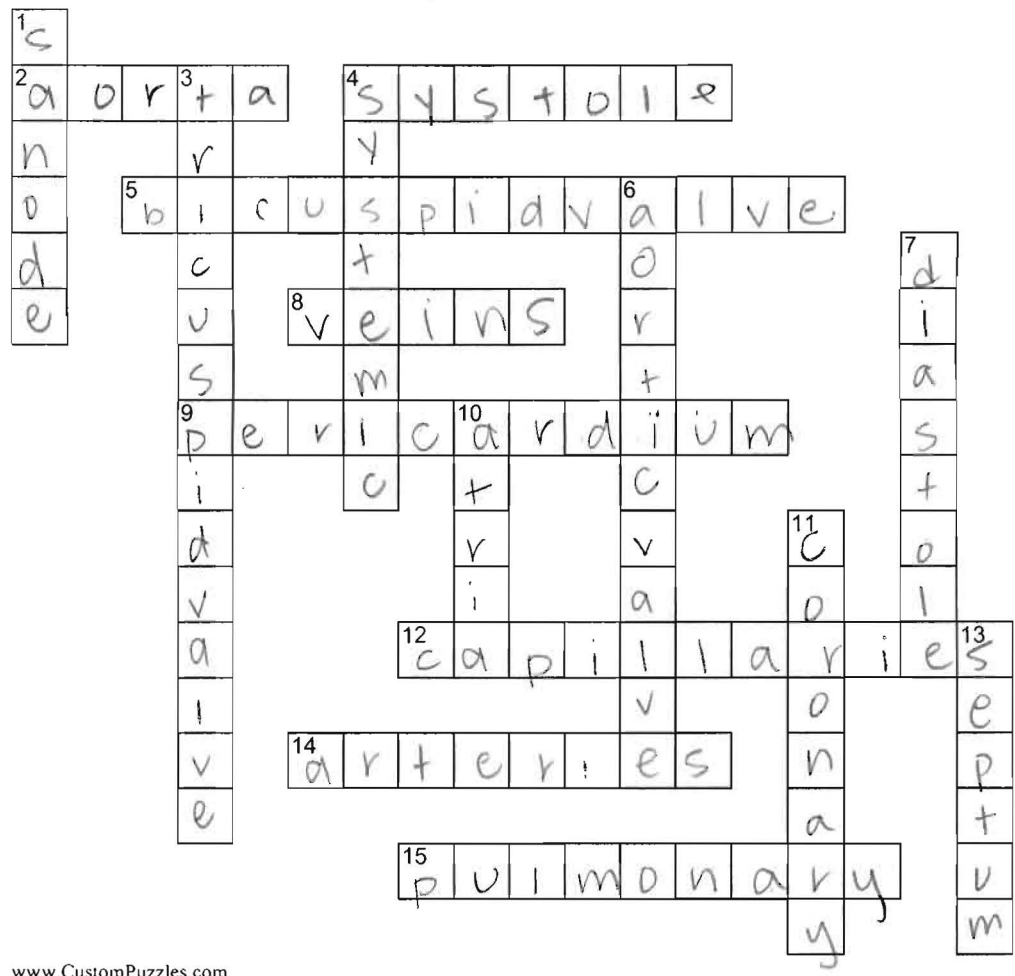

- ~~4~~ contraction of the ventricles
- ~~5~~ the left atrioventricular valve is thicker and heavier than the right; it is made of 2 flaps. What is it also called?
- ~~8~~ oxygenated blood from the lungs and deoxygenated blood from the body tissues is carried through these
- ~~9~~ the sac that surrounds and protects the heart
- ~~12~~ Exchanges between the blood and the cells take place through these.
- ~~14~~ blood is pumped to the lungs and body tissues through these
- ~~15~~ The vessels that are related to the lungs
